

Announcement of the Ministry of Labour

Subject: Specification of Occupations which may constitute danger to public safety.

Thus, occupations should be carried out by those holding licenses

It is seen as appropriate to specify occupations which may constitute danger to public safety. Thus, it is mandatory these occupations be carried out by those holding license.

According to section 6 and section 7 (2), Skill Development Promotion Act B.E. 2545, amendment of Skill Development Promotion Act (No. 2) B.E. 2557, the Minister of Labour, with the propose of the Committee of Skill Development Promotion and the approval of the Cabinet, has announced the essence accordingly.

Title 1 This announcement is called “the Announcement of the Ministry of Labour, subject: Specification of Occupations which may constitute danger to public safety; therefore these occupations should be carried out by those holding licenses.

Title 2 The announcement is enacted 365 days after the approved royal gazette.

Title 3 Occupations namely electrician, electronics and computer, specifically inside wiremen may constitute danger to public safety. Thus, these occupations should be carried out by those holding licenses based on the Skill Development Promotion Act.
