NOTIFICATION OF THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR

RE: REPORTING OF THE PERFORMANCE UNDER THE LABOUR PROTECTION IN FISHING WORK
ACT B.E. 2562 (2019)

To ensure that the reporting of the performance under the Labour Protection in Fishing Work Act B.E. 2562 (2019) is in order, efficient and in accordance with the international standard.

By virtue of section 6 paragraph four of the Labour Protection in Fishing Work Act B.E. 2562 (2019), the Minister of Labour hereby issues the Notification as follows:

Clause 1. The agencies responsible for the law on labour protection, the law on labour protection in fishing work, the law on recruitment and jobseeker protection, the law on navigation in the Thai waters, the law on foreigners' working management, the law on fisheries, the law on compensation and the law on labour relations shall conduct the report and analysis of the performance relating to the situations, numbers of cases, proceeding of the related agencies and future perspective of the work related to labour protection in fishing work and submit it to the National Operation Center on Prevention and Suppression of Human Trafficking, Ministry of Labour, at least once a year.

Clause 2. The Command Center of Prevention on Labour Trafficking , Ministry of Labour, shall collect the performance result of the agencies under clause 1 to conduct the performance report under the Labour Protection in Fishing Work Act B.E. 2562 (2019) and present It to the Council of Ministers every July or under the duration as deemed appropriate by the Minister of Labour.
